ELECTIVE REGISTRATION HELPFUL TIPS

- Only one child can be registered at a time for electives.
- Please pay close attention to the [age requirements](#) for each elective.
- For the two electives that occur over multiple days (Worship and High Five News Team), you must register for that elective [each day that it occurs!](#)
- Unfortunately, due to the limitations of CCB, if an elective fills up before you complete your child's elective registration, you will have to restart the registration process and your child will not be able to sign up for that elective. We know this can be frustrating and apologize in advance, but please know it is a limitation of the software.

ELECTIVES

While High Five has the elements of dynamic worship and teaching that you'd see in most VBS programs, what makes it unique is being able to create your own schedule by choosing from a catalog of electives. These electives are age-appropriate, experience-oriented and fun. The purpose of these electives is for each child to be introduced to something new, but not necessarily master in one hour. Electives are led by individuals from our faith family.

Electives are first-come, first-served. Each elective has a maximum capacity and is limited to specific ages. Two electives occur over multiple days/sessions. All electives are subject to change depending on unforeseen circumstances, such as weather or changes by our elective leaders.

If you would like to have your first choice for each elective, we suggest you register as soon as registration opens on Monday, April 26 at 1PM. Registration closes on Monday, May 3 at 5PM.

LARGE GROUP GATHERING

To begin each morning, we will gather in the Worship Center for high-energy worship, dynamic teaching and interactive games. This time together will focus our hearts on the Lord as we go throughout our day.

SNACKS

Each day, we will provide a snack between elective sessions. Water will be available all day. If your child has food allergies or dietary restrictions, please provide an alternative snack marked with your child's name at check-in each morning. Here is the list of snacks that will be provided:
