ROMANS 6:15-23

1. How does sin lead to death? How does obedience lead to righteousness?

3. What fruit did sin produce in you before you met Jesus?
4. How can "the end of those things" bring death in us?
5. How can we present our members as slaves of righteousness? How can this lead to sanctification?

1. What does this passage teach us about God's design and intention for marriage?

5. How is sin dead without the law?
6. How does sin deceive us and kill us?
7. Why is the law a good thing?

3. What good thing do you keep failing to do? How can you seek God's help in this right now?
4. What does it mean to "delight in the law of God in my inner being"?
